Phoenix Ball 2008 celebrates 10th anniversary with awesome show

Adding to the festivities, MC's Ron Lenyk and Derwin Wong had the audience laughing in the aisles as they presented their own unique version of the live auction filled with various costume changes and silly physical comedy skits, including their own interpretation of a Chinese lion dance.
